Parents and Guardians Code of Conduct

Parents and guardians have a significant influence on player's experience in this sporting adventure. Your behavior and attitude directly affect not only your child but also other players, coaches, and officials. Therefore, we expect all parents and guardians to set a positive example at all times.

Be a Positive Role Model

- Act as a positive role model in terms of language, attitude, and sportsmanship. Encourage good behavior and applaud great effort and performance from both your team and the opposition.
- Never use inappropriate, foul, abusive, or aggressive language toward anyone, including children, coaches, officials, or opponents.
- Model good sportsmanship at all times.

Respect Authority & Boundaries

- Respect and support the decisions of all coaches and referees without question. Refrain from any verbal or gestural abuse toward them.
- Do not coach or shout instructions to players from the sidelines during training or matches.
 Your role is to support, not to instruct.
- Do not enter the training or match field at any time.

Parents and Guardians Code of Conduct

Handle Concerns Respectfully

- In the event of a conflict or an incident involving your child, please allow the coaches to resolve the matter. Do not take matters into your own hands.
- Any questions or concerns about the team, coaching, or player development should be raised through the designated communication channels. All communication with coaches must be respectful and constructive.

Support the Club

- Be responsible for transporting your child to and from training and matches on a timely basis.
- Ensure your child is fully kitted in the official Lagos Tigers uniform for all training and matches. Players will not be allowed to participate without the proper kit.
- Fully support and enable your child and the coaches to comply with the club's Player Code of Conduct.

Player Code of Conduct

Respect and Sportsmanship

- Show genuine respect to everyone, including teammates, coaches, opponents, referees, and club officials.
- Avoid unsportsmanlike conduct, aggressive behavior, foul language, and any form of violence.
- Cheating or any dishonest behavior is strictly prohibited.
- Always play to the best of your ability and within the spirit and laws of the game.

Ambassadorial Conduct

- Represent the Lagos Tigers with pride both on and off the pitch.
- Your behavior reflects on the club's values.
- Never use inappropriate, foul, or abusive language.

Punctuality and Preparedness

- Be on time for all training sessions and matches.
- Arrive with the required gears for training and match sessions.
- Wear the official club jersey and shorts for all matches.
- Notify your team supervisor and coach in advance if you are unable to attend a training or game.

Player Code of Conduct

Adherence to Authority

- Accept the decisions of the coach and the referee without dissent.
- Never challenge their authority.
- Abide by the instructions of your team manager and coaches.

Prohibited Electronic Devices

 The use of mobile phones or personal electronic devices is strictly forbidden during training sessions and matches.

• Consequences

 Consistent reprimand for undesirable behaviour can lead to expulsion from the club with parents being informed of the decision.
